Opened in 1991, Bancroft NeuroRehab is a division of Bancroft, a leading nonprofit service provider for people with neurological disabilities.



Bancroft NeuroRehab therapists treat a wide range of neurological disorders, including traumatic brain injury, concussion, anoxic or hypoxic brain injury, stroke, brain tumor, mild cognitive impairment, Alzheimer's disease/dementia, multiple sclerosis, Parkinson's disease and attention deficit disorder.

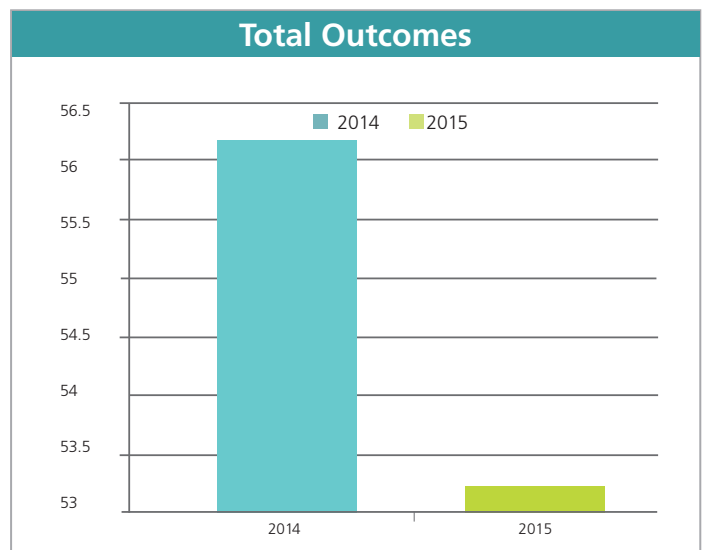
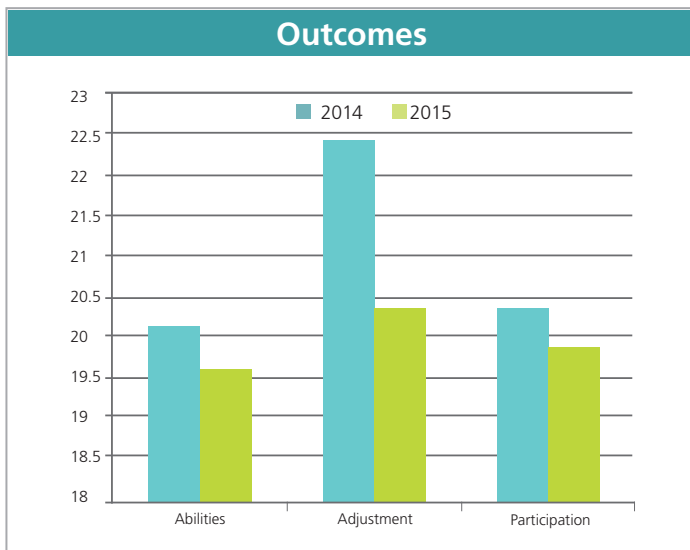

Positive outcomes reflect effective programming

The Mayo-Portland Adaptability Inventory – Fourth Edition (MPAI-4) provides a standardized measure of abilities, adjustment, and social/community participation, and is one of the primary outcome measures used at Bancroft NeuroRehab. A score of zero on any item indicates the individual is experiencing no functional impairment; higher scores are associated with higher levels of impairment. Each year Bancroft NeuroRehab tracks the MPAI scores of our clients to ensure the quality of care being provided. The scores below indicate that our clients at Bancroft NeuroRehab had a lower overall level of impairment in 2015 as compared to 2014.

Scores that **decrease** reflect individuals' **improvement**, as measured by the Mayo-Portland Adaptability Inventory.

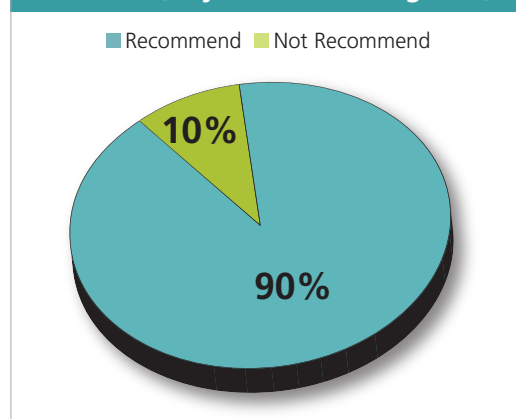


Bancroft NeuroRehab is accredited by CARF International (Commission on Accreditation of
